POS systems like Square or Clover, that rely on WiFi networks. Unfortunately,

However, <u>concrete is difficult for WiFi signals to penetrate</u> impacting performance and the overall WiFi experience. have to have a good internet connection or otherwise, you could lose a sale,"
